Paper

- 1 sheet of Canson Mi-Teintes Drawing Paper 19" x 25", Flannel Gray
- Sketch paper pad/book/loose sheets
 - For warm-up and quick exercises

Drawing Materials

- (2-3) <u>Sanguine pencils</u> (e.g., Conté à Paris Sanguine 612, or General's Sanguine)
- (2) <u>Sanguine Medici</u> pencils
- 1 <u>Sanguine Stick</u> Conté à Paris Sketching Pastel Carrés, Sanguine Watteau
- 1 <u>white chalk pencil</u> (e.g., General's White Charcoal Pencil)
- 1 kneaded eraser
- 1 hard eraser (e.g., Mars Staedtler white plastic eraser)
- 1 X-Acto knife (for sharpening), I will have some available to borrow
- 1 sandpaper block (for fine sharpening)

Blending Tools

- 1 <u>small blending stump</u> (optional)
- Soft, bristle, and or makeup brushes (*optional*)
 Make sure they are clean with no paint/medium residue.
- Paper towel (optional)
